

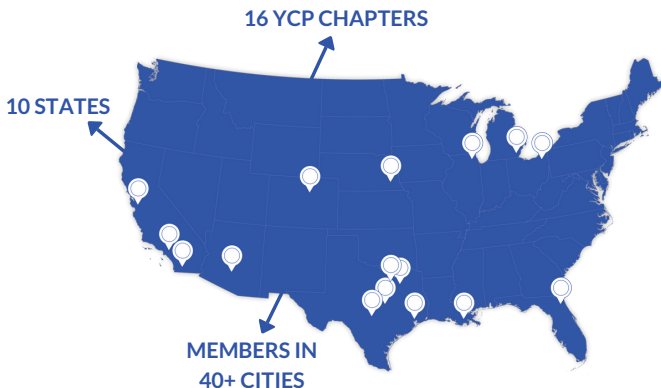
Jennifer Baugh
